



# 2013 AFMLTA Conference Scholarship - 2019

## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

### **What is the 2013 AFMLTA Conference Scholarship?**

This scholarship was established after the success of the AFMLTA National Conference 2013 which was hosted by the MLTA ACT Inc. in Canberra to coincide with Canberra's centenary. It provides financial assistance for teachers wishing to attend conferences to further their professional development by means of the payment of conference registration fees.

### **Who can apply?**

A financial MLTA ACT Inc. member may apply for this scholarship if:

- they are an active member of the MLTA ACT Inc. and have been a financial member for at least two years prior to applying for the scholarship. An exception to this requirement may be granted to New Educators (teachers in their first three years of teaching),
- they intend to continue to work as a languages teacher,
- they will use the scholarship for the purpose of payment of conference registration fees,
- they will submit a report of their activity for publication in CONTACT newsletter for the benefit of members of the MLTA ACT Inc. and/or present at one of the events organised by the MLTA ACT Inc. (TeachMeet, Mini Conference, etc.) as requested by the Executive Committee.

Your application must include the details below and any other information that would be of assistance:

- Full name
- Current school
- Number of years as a member of the MLTA ACT Inc.
- Language teaching experience
- Outline of any contribution made to teaching languages beyond the applicant's own school
- Provide a summary of the lectures you intend to attend and detail how this will assist in your professional development as a languages teacher
- List any previous scholarships received from the MLTA ACT Inc.
- Any members who will be presenting at the conference must detail how their attendance will contribute to the professional learning of the language teachers' community

### **Who is on the selection committee?**

For the *2013 AFMLTA Conference Scholarship* for 2019, five members of the Executive Committee of the MLTA ACT Inc. will review all applications. Successful applicants will be notified of the Executive Committee's decision no later than 3:00pm Friday 22 March 2019. The names of the successful applicants will be forwarded to the Treasurer of the MLTA ACT Inc.

Funds will be reimbursed to the applicants when receipts are provided, not in advance.

The decision of the Executive Committee shall be final and no correspondence will be entered into in respect to any decision made. The Executive Committee will not publish their reasons for any decision reached or any aspect of the *2013 AFMLTA Conference Scholarship* for 2019.
