Canberra region wineries—take a day to snoop around the vineyards near Lake George and Murrumbateman

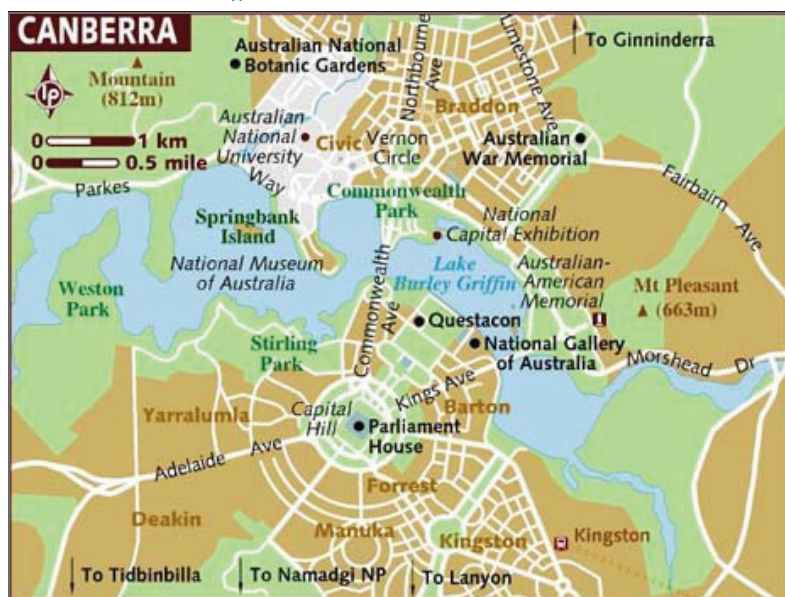
